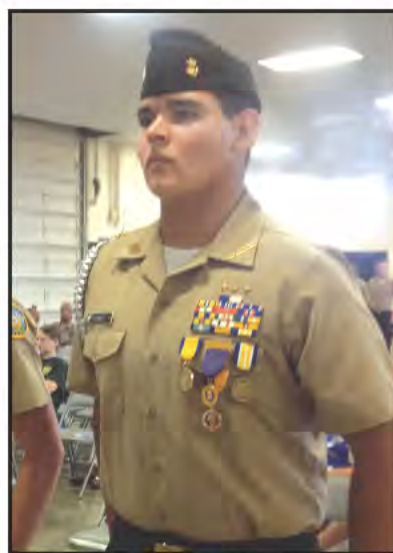


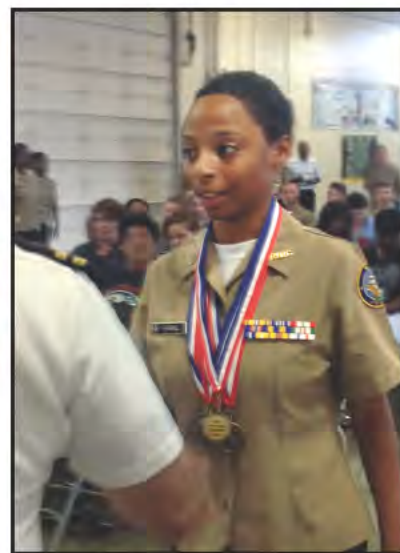
NNDCC Participates in Training

Cadet Ariona Yates earned a ribbon and a certificate for completing BLT.

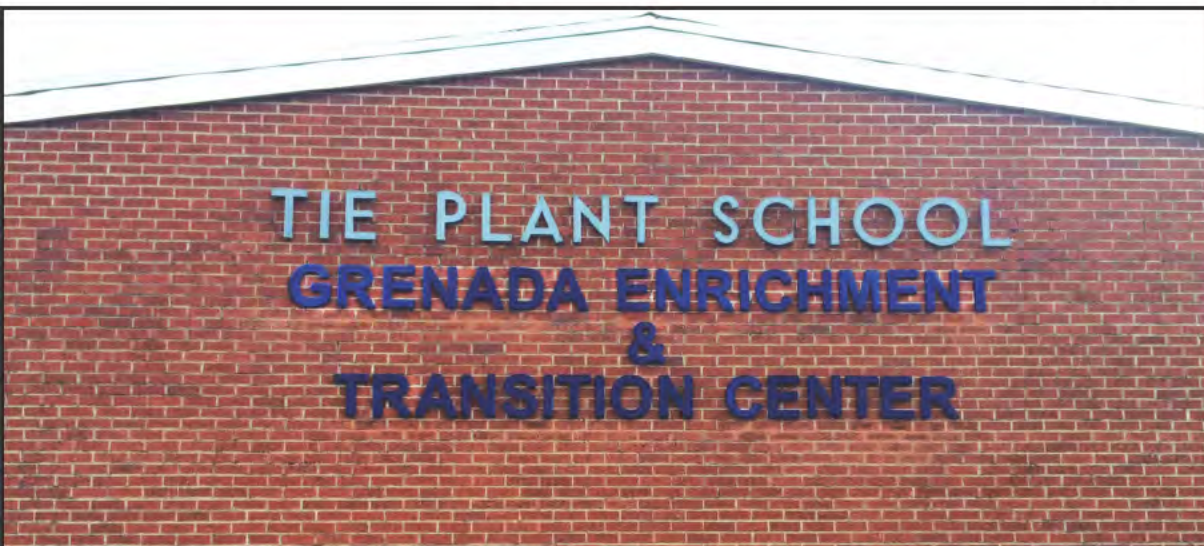
