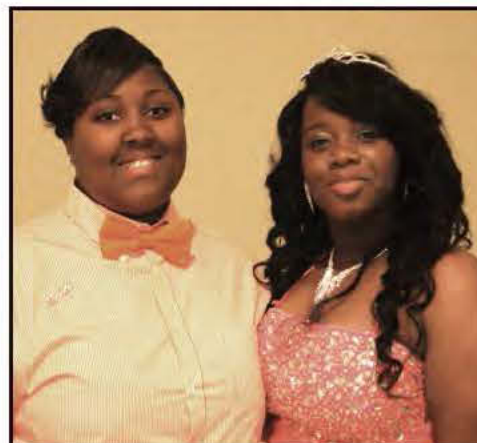
# NNDCC Holds Annual Ball
