Electronic entry systems with audio and video are being added at all schools as part of GSD's upgrades to safety procedures. These entry systems provide a screening check in process for all visitors to campus, part of the additional initiatives of our Crisis Management Plan. Since all exterior doors are locked, the entry systems provide a monitored access

point at each school. Our plan has been reevaluated and additional safety procedures have been implemented, with several other projects in progress. Our Crisis Management Plan follows the Mississippi Department of Education's outline and was approved with input from local government and emergency officials.
