

GSD Adds Another Successful Band Night

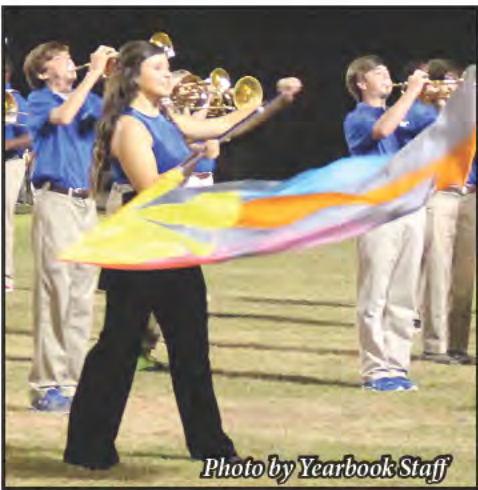
