The Grenada High School Marching Band has been working endless hours in preparation for this year's contest season. The marching band will be competing in four competitions across three different states this year.

Beginning the contest season, the marching band achieved their 37th consecutive year of all Superior ratings in the Region 2 MHSAA MBA State Marching Evaluations. Superiors were obtained in Percussion, Color Guard, Band and Drum Majors. Marching Evaluations were held October 8th at Grenada's own Charger Field. Grenada hosted thousands of spectators and performers as over 20 bands from across the northwest region of Mississippi who came to Grenada to receive their annual state ratings.

After getting their state festival ratings, the Grenada Marching Band will take their hard work to the regional level. The following Saturday, October 15th, the marching band will be traveling to compete against schools from Mississippi and Alabama in the Wayne County Invi-

tation to be held at Wayne County High School in Wayneboro, Mississippi.

On October 22th they will be traveling to Lake Charles, Louisiana, to compete in the "Showdown at Sunday" against schools from Mississippi, Louisiana, and Texas on the campus of McNeese State University.

Grenada Bands will finish up their competitive marching season in Newburn, Tennessee, participating in the Choctaw Classic, featuring bands from Mississippi, Arkansas, and Tennessee at Dyer County High School.

In this contest season the Grenada Bands will travel over 1,500 miles, compete against bands from 6 different states, namely Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana, Tennessee, Alabama, and Texas, with competition from over 75 different groups, and judging panels from all over the United States. The band directors look forward to a great marching season and wish the students good luck as they continue to work hard and achieve their best.
